

Accessing AACTE edTPA Resource Library Documents

New organizations

All organizations that want to have edTPA access should fill out an application which is located here:

There are two different types of applications.

EPP- “educator preparation program or an alternative certification program that will be actively preparing teacher candidates”

Associate- “association, organization, department of education or other stakeholder in edTPA work”

Superintendents, Principals, and Cooperating Teachers

You can gain access through an Educator Preparation Program you support. In the account manager area, the coordinator of the Educator Preparation Program can request for you to become a consultant. A profile is created for you and you are given consultant access.

Candidates

Your Educator Preparation Program and your edTPA coordinator can provide you with edTPA materials through your institution’s online platform and other secure environments. Please register on Pearson’s website edtpa.com for access through your institution’s platform provider. Additional information on candidate registration, submission, and scoring is available on their site as well.

Educator Preparation Program edTPA Coordinators

There are two ways to update/change coordinators. The new or previous coordinator can request the change by emailing the edtpa@aacte.org and copying their chief representative/dean on the email. Or the chief representative can log into their account and change the institution’s coordinator manually.

Educator Preparation Program Faculty

Faculty can request edTPA access through their profile and the edTPA coordinator grants the access after they receive an email. Faculty can log in or create an account here: <https://secure.aacte.org/apps/edtpa/>

The coordinator can add faculty to their institutional roster, and then add them to their edTPA roster. The coordinator can manage both of these rosters in the account manager. <https://secure.aacte.org/apps/edtpa/edtpa.php>
